Year 2000 Expenditure

1. Purpose

To advise the Committee of the costs incurred to date by the Council in mitigating the risks posed by the Year 2000 issue.

2. Background

At the Policy and Finance Committee Meeting on 8 April 1999 I was requested to make an assessment of the costs incurred by the Council on the Year 2000 issue.

An assessment has now been made of the external costs incurred by each division as a result of the Year 2000 issue.

While there has also been considerable internal management time spent on the issue, this has not been included, primarily for practical reasons (ie timesheets for all staff involved do not record time at a sufficient level of detail to facilitate the analysis).

3. Results

In addition, the Utility Services Division is forecasting to spend a further \$220,000 on new laboratory software, replacement of equipment and additional communications equipment. There are no significant additional expenditure requirements in other divisions.
