1. **Regional Plans**

A summary of the status of the various Environment Court references on regional plans is attached. Changes from the last meeting are shown in bold.

(1) Regional Coastal Plan (Bianca Sullivan)

The outstanding appeals relating to Titahi Bay have been put back before the Environment Court. We are seeking a judicial conference to determine how the matter is to proceed. The remaining outstanding issue is the northern boundary of the car free area, where the parties have not been able to reach agreement.

(2) **Regional Plan for Discharges to Land (Kirsten Forsyth)**

The remaining appeal from Mrs Atkinson was settled by consent order on 21 August 1999. The Council can now make the Plan operative, and we hope to put it to the next Policy and Finance Committee meeting for final approval.

(3) Regional Air Quality Management Plan (Nicki Kinghorn)

Unfortunately the stack testing of a spray painting operation in the Moir Street area has had to be delayed. The testing is now scheduled for the end of October. The results should provide sufficient information to determine the appropriate limits on the rules in the Plan, and hence resolve the appeal from the Moir Street residents.

(4) Regional Freshwater Plan (Kirsten Forsyth, Murray McLea)

All remaining issues with the Plan have been resolved and we hope to bring it to the next Policy and Finance Committee meeting for final approval.

(5) Regional Soil Plan (Nicki Kinghorn)

Significant issues still remain unresolved despite a judicial conference. A hearing has been scheduled for December to address jurisdictional matters. We continue to pursue all avenues to resolve the outstanding issues

2. Regional Plan Implementation (Jo Fagan)

(1) **Community Beach and Stream Clean-ups (Jo Fagan)**

Jo Fagan undertook the regional co-ordination role for this year's *Clean Up New Zealand Week* which involved assisting territorial authorities and community groups to organise a large number of beach, stream, park and street clean-ups around the western Wellington Region.

(2) Guidelines for the Environmentally Sound Disposal of Agricultural Wastes (Kirsten Forsyth)

Work has commenced on this project with the completion of a project brief. The guidelines will be developed with representatives of the farming community, territorial authorities, and other relevant organisations and community groups.

(3) **On-site Sewage Treatment (Kirsten Forsyth)**

Staff are working on a joint project with local authorities in the Manawatu-Wanganui Region to produce documents on on-site sewage treatment and disposal. A first draft technical report has been completed and released for internal review, and four pamphlets drafted.

3. **Iwi matters (Tracey Whare)**

A workshop is scheduled for 1 November to discuss how the Council can further develop its relationship with the Tangata Whenua of the Region. A paper with a suggested approach is being prepared.

Councillors will be meeting with Tangata Whenua to discuss the Long Term Financial Strategy on 21 October and 16 November.

4. Staff

Mr Jan Hania has been appointed to the position of Hazard Analyst in the Department. Jan is currently working for consultants in Christchurch and recently completed a natural resources engineering degree at Lincoln University. Prior to his degree, Jan was a communications officer in the RNZAF.

We are hoping to second a staff member from Ngati Kahungunu to the Department to fill the gap created by Bianca Sullivan's five month leave of absence.
