Mr Garlick said that Mayor Terris, who was unable to be present this morning, had requested that the Wellington Regional Council be thanked for proposing the commissioning of the temporary use of Gear Island Water Treatment Plant so that unfluoridated water can be supplied to Petone consumers while a permanent solution to the supply of water to Petone is considered.

Mr Garlick said Hutt City had examined the Memorandum of Understanding and were happy to be a party to an agreement except for Clause 9.

Mr Garlick noted that Clause 9 stated the agreement would not come into effect until the Regional Council and the Hutt City Council had agreed to the funding of a permanent unfluoridated water supply to Petone and Korokoro through the Rahui Reservoir. Mr Garlick said that Hutt City would like the temporary Gear Island proposal to be commenced as soon as possible and not be unnecessarily delayed while a permanent solution is negotiated.

Mr Garlick concluded by saying that Hutt City agreed that the temporary solution should not extend beyond 31 December 2000.

The Chairperson thanked Mr Garlick for his representations and said these would be considered by members when the item was debated later in the meeting.

Vera Allen, Deputy Chairperson, Petone Community Board

Vera Allen said that Petone residents had been convinced that the Regional Council had turned its back on the desires of the local community. The Regional Council's proposal for today to offer temporary use of the Gear Island Water Treatment Plant for the supply of unfluoridated water in the Petone water supply is gratefully received by residents. Vera Allen said she would especially like to thank officers of the Wellington Regional Council and the Hutt City Council, Councillor McQueen and two Hutt representatives on the Regional Council for their support.

The Chairperson adjourned the meeting at 9.45am in order to commence the Policy and Finance Committee meeting.
