I have just returned from England after attending a British Council international seminar on *Sustainable Communities and Local Agenda 21*.

The seminar was very relevant to what this Council is doing with its Long-Term Financial Strategy and I hope that I have an opportunity to talk to all Councillors about it.

Interestingly the idea of sustainable communities is well accepted in England and the word *sustainable* is part of the vernacular. In my opinion that is not the case in New Zealand - perhaps because we don't face the same kind or degree of pressures currently facing other parts of the world. However, trends tell us that we could be heading in the same direction.

We have the prime opportunity now to ensure that we don't make the same mistakes in New Zealand. I hope that this Council can contribute in some way to a *Sustainable Wellington Region*.
