- 8. s101J(4) Any person who has lodged an objection under subsection (2) may lodge an appeal to the Local Government Commission against the Council decision in respect of that objection. Closing date to be not earlier than one month from giving of public notice and not later than **20 December 2000.**
- 9. s101J(7) If an appeal is received Council shall send a copy, together with all objections, resolutions and supporting information to the Commission as soon as practicable but not later than **15 January 2000.**

**Note:** Following the timetable above, should there be an appeal against the Council decision, relevant material should be sent to the Local Government Commission in early November 2000.
