4. **Variance Explanation**

Increased logging revenue is anticipated at this stage due to higher tonnage and the better quality blocks we anticipate logging in 2000/01. However, correspondingly there is an increase in contractor and consultant costs which when combined with lower other income streams and increased financial costs due to a higher opening debt balance, generates a reduced pre-dividend operating surplus.
