- (2)(a) That the land contained in CT 17C/429 and part of the land in CT 17C/430 totalling approximately 2.25 hectares (including the 63 Mabey Road house site) as shown on Attachment 2, be declared surplus to requirements.
- (b) That officers be authorised to proceed with the subdivision of the Mabey Road depot site, the development of the new depot site and the sale of the surplus land in accordance with the project plan (Attachment 1) and proposed new depot layout plan (Attachment 2) outlined in this report.
- (c) That a budget of \$83,500, to be funded from sale proceeds, be approved to meet the project costs
- (d) That in accordance with Section 40 of the Public Works Act 1981 the surplus property be sold by, either:
  - offer to the former owner or their successor, at the current market value as assessed by a registered valuer, or at any lesser price considered reasonable by Council's Chief Executive, or
  - on the open market at the current market value and in a manner approved by the Chief Executive, should the former owner have no interest in the land, or in the event of an exemption being appropriate.
- (e) That the net proceeds from the disposal of the surplus property be allocated to retirement of Flood Protection Department debt
- (f) That the Authorised Signatory of the Council Secretary and/or the Council seal be affixed to the necessary documents to achieve the subdivision and the disposal of the surplus land
