Utility Services Division - Plantation Forestry: Proposed Business Plan 2003-2013

1. Purpose

To seek approval of the proposed Business Plan for Plantation Forestry, including any amendments approved by the Committee.

2. Exclusion of the Public

3. Greater Wellington Plantation Forestry Operating Plan for 2003/04 and Projections to 2013 and Beyond

The Operating Plan, which has been provided separately and will be tabled at the meeting on 4 March 2003, contains considerable strategic, operational and financial detail of this activity.

This overview summarises the position as we currently see it and the assumptions made. Attached is the summary review of the Income Statement and Debt to Value graph.

4. Key Features

- Cutting plan revised resulting in higher revenue as harvest volumes increase.
- Corresponding increase in contractors costs because of rising harvest volumes.

- Other operating expenses similar to 2002/03 budget.
- Budgeted financial costs up by \$30,000.
- Debt reaches \$12.2M by June 2004 but below treasury limit of 70%.
- Dividend of \$150,000 pa provided.
- No contribution is assumed for public good component of activity.
