# Appointments to E!loartls of Directors - Council LATEs

## 1. Purpose

To approve appointtlli nts of I )ircctors of WRC Holdings Limited, Pringle House Limited and Port Invest tnents Limited. IO take effect from I May 2002.

## 2. Background

- (1) Counci'l on 5 March '002 approved a process for appointment of Directors. (Report 02.11 I 3 to tha meeting is appended (Attachment 1) together with the Resolutions ~~cloptcd |>: Council (Attachment 2). The Council approved:
  - (a) .4ppolutment (1' the Council Deputy Chairperson as a Director of all three Comp;mics 1~1111 effect f?om I May 2002.
  - (b) 'The lmccss li I appointment of a third Councillor Director to the Board by 30 .1pril.
  - (c) 'The p1m33s li) appointment of two external Directors to take effect from I Ma\ 2002.
- (2) III pursuing IIIC agree I processes, Councillor McDavitt and I, assisted by Mr Maguire, 21 St enga21.d Mr David Hutton (ex Public Trustee), who is an experienced I Greetor end is familiar with Public Sector Enterprises. He was sugge, <tcd by rhc ltlstil:lte of Directors and provided a very valuable independent perspective 011 candid; Its.
- (3) It Ivat< decided to id< ntify potential directors by direct approach and not by advertisemtm1, Interest ed Councillors were invited to submit their names for the Councillor V;I ~ney;I Ed several Councillors suggested the names of potential candid;.Ites lb the CXI rnal Director vacancies. The interest of some external candid;.Ites V, ;!s alreac v on record. All candidates including the four retiring

external Directrors (all of whom sought reappointment) were asked to provide CVs amI WCIY interview \,cd. Mr 1 lutton participated in all interviews.

I was also considered that a balance was essential between continu 1 ty of' I~~KI~F.~ lip in terms of background knowledge and understanding of the three (Imipanic, and their roles, while at the same tinie introducing new membel~~s to tlle Board It should be noted that my involvement with the Boards is conlparati\ c ly rece't I and adoption of the recommendations contained in this report \J~QLIICI mean thl''c Directors would have comparatively little experience of these C~,mipai~ics.

In addition to his extensive experience and knowledge of public and private sector ellterprises, Cr Long's Wairarapa perspective would also be of coll~iderable ~lssistance to the Boards.

(b) I'wo I<xternal Directors - Mrs Anne Blackburn and Mr Stuart Macaskill

Mrs l<~.ackhun will not be known to niost Councillors and her CV is attacl-cd (Attac~hment 3). A reference check has been undertaken with Mr 13n:nt I,a]vt<sub>5</sub> III, the Chair of the Board of AgRescarch, which she is currenrly a mer llber of. The view was expressed that in that capacity Mrs Blackl~rn hat proved to be a very competent Director who brings particllar skill in the areas of governance and finance. Her work experl~nce has also given her strong skills in commercial judgment and properly IIMWICI~~. It was considered that she "is a very strong candig&l.ltc who :vould be a good Director for the WRC."

In terms of particular > II.ills each Director would bring, all arc considered to offer the necessary c,;trategic Jiew and a good understanding of Statement of Corporate IntentiAccoui ilability 1 ~~wc'sscs. Between them the recommended new Directors also offer a b;llance of hound commicreial, property and financial expertise.

(7) The Sciennin Group ) of the view that terms of appointment generally, should be for l.hrec J m-s (as sith Councillors). As has been our experience this time, there is benefit in the I m' appointments not being made until a new Council has had the oppm I I mity to ~sscss its approach.

The Screening Group , also of the view that continuity would best be achieved by retmning  $\sim$ hc  $_{SCI-\backslash I}$  cs of Mr Macaskill for a term of two years when the positior  $_{COLI}$  c: again IX reviewed and provide an opportunity for a fLIrther injection of ;I new fat\, at the Board table. Mr Macaskill also demonstrated a high lc'rel of 'rl~e attr-ibllics required of a Director of the Companies.

- (8) Bccause these appoint 1 I lents are made under the Companies Act, there is a formal process of application by way of special resolutions. These will be as follows:

(b) It shotlId be Imted, also, that WRC Holdings Limited, as the sole shareholder of I'ringle I-louse Limited and Port Investments Limited will also ~ieed to bass special resolutions appointing the saint persons as Direc,l,jrs of 1'1 ingle I-louse Limited and Port Investments Limited with effec~ f?om I Llay 2002. A me&ing of the Board of WRC Holdings Limited will bi, convened prior to I May to pass these resolutions.

#### 3. Communications

Once the deciGons ; IIC made ,md all candidates notified of the outcome, a press release will be issued ;~nnoullcing the ,q~pointments.

#### 4. Recommendations

That the Council:

- (a) As sole shareholder of WRC Holdings Limited, resolve as a Special Resolution that Terence McDavit, Richard Long, Anne Blackburn and Stuart Macaskill be appointed as Directors of WRC Holdings Limited with effect from 1 May 2002.
- (b) That the appointments be for terms of three years from 1 May 2002, except for Mr Macaskill whose oppointment be for a term of two years to 30 April 2004.

(c) Note that WRC Holdings Limited, as sole shareholder of Pringle House Limited and Port Investments / imited, will need to resolve as a Special Resolution that Terence McDavitt, Ri hard Long, Anne Blackburn and Stuart Macaskill be appointed as Director, of Pringle House Limited and Port Investments Limited with effect from 1 May '002 for the same terms as in (b).
