However, they indicated the possibility of sharing facilities during the construction period. No public access along the stopbank was reiterated.</p>

Design considerations were raised in consultation re a floodwall on the eastern boundary and it is noted that a low mound would be preferred for maintenance reasons. No public access along the stopbank was reiterated. At the Public Meeting 25 October, the red alignment was stated as preferred. Stormwater issues around the pond continue to be of importance. In the 20 Nov 06 meeting, Hutt representatives indicated if Boulcott is a Blue alignment then Hutt will follow a Blue alignment. In this case, both clubs would also require a low level bank to protect from frequent flooding. If Boulcott cease to exist due to any other alignment, Hutt is willing to discuss amalgamation options. Hutt also would like to see a Red stopbank protecting both courses.</p>

In some instances their stance relaxed with the provision of more information.
