



Soldiers Settlement Road

Entrance to Lake Domain, creating a sense of arrival and view shaft to lake

Set up new fence or repair existing fence along the boundary

Plant native tree and shrub species typical of the area to establish shelter for recreation and parking

Keep existing macrocampa and pine trees along the boundary for shelter and underplant with indigenous species. Gradually remove macrocampa and pines over time

Reshape landform into undulating mound for shelter around picnicking from north

Investigate renovating / developing existing toilet block to create a shelter structure for picnicking, children's climbing structure, lake viewing lookout from roof

Vehicle & boat trailer parking area

Lake view platform with interpretation and directional information

Reshape landform for use as trail bike area (option A)

Vehicle access to Simmonds Lagoon area

Keep existing poplar trees to recognise European settlement activities

Maintain and develop grassed area for picnicking and passive recreation

Reshape landform into undulating mound for shelter from south for picnicking

Plant riparian/wetland species to enhance ecological value at lake shore

Walkway along lake shore

Boardwalk to lake edge

Reshape landform for use as trail bike area (option B)

Maintain and develop walkway along the stopbank and lake shore through the reserve, with future link through to Turner Lagoon

Investigate use of former yacht clubrooms for commercial / information use e.g. windsurfing, boat hire

Keep / upgrade existing jetty structure
