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## The cost of a resource consent for a bore

### What charges can I expect when applying for a resource consent?

Before your application is accepted you will be charged a fee of \$225.00 (including GST) based on our current charging policy. This fee covers two hours of our time to log and review your application.

### What ongoing charges can I expect?

Some bore consents have a one-off compliance monitoring charge of \$151.88 (including GST) that is charged in September/October of the year the consent is granted. This is usually bores constructed in confined artesian aquifers and unsealed bores/wells in unconfined aquifers. You will be advised when your bore consent is processed whether you will receive a one-off compliance monitoring charge.

The charge covers a compliance visit in the first year to ensure the bore has been properly constructed. The charge is made up of a site inspection lasting half an hour, a written report and a \$35 customer service charge.

If you comply with all the conditions of your consent you will not have to pay any further charges.
