## Request for information 2023-102

I refer to your request for information dated 1 May 2023, which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 1 May 2023. You have requested the following:

"For 2020/21, 2021/22 and 2022/23 (to date) broken down by year please provide:

• Staff sickness absence figures for each department in the Council. Also detail average departmental sickness days against departmental sickness targets.

For 2020/21, 2021/22 and 2022/23 (to date) broken down by year please provide:

• Number of resignations within each department in the Council. If you do not collate resignation figures for each department please provide figures for the Council as a whole."

## **Greater Wellington's response follows:**

Please refer to **Attachment 1** for Greater Wellington's staff sickness and resignation numbers. Greater Wellington does not have departmental sickness targets. We are therefore refusing your request for the average departmental sickness days against departmental sickness targets under section 17(g) of the Local Government Official Information Act 1987 (the Act) on the ground that the information is not held by Greater Wellington and we have no grounds for believing that the information is held by another local authority or a department of Minister of the Crown or organisation.

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this letter, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Act.
