copies of all reports and minutes held by your local body relating to any analysis conducted or proposed of the relative benefis and disadvantages, including economic, environmental and social considerations, within the past 10 years, of your local body investment in or development of exotic plantations versus indigenous forests."

Greater Wellington's response follows:
